Functions & Responsibilities:

- Organization of inter and intra institutional workshops, seminars, conferences on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles.
- Organization of orientation, refresher, thematic, short-term, long-term programs to promote quality academic and non-academic staff development.
- Organization of one day seminar on ethics, integrity and values for staff and students.
- Documentation of various professional activities leading to quality enhancement.
- Be nodal agency of the institution for coordinating quality related activities including adoption, adaptation and dissemination of best practices.
- Developing and maintenance of institutional Data base through MIS for the purpose of maintaining/ enhancing the institutional quality.
- Development of quality culture in the institution.
- Organizing programs on policy issues, soft skill development etc for the students, teachers & non-academic staff of the institution.
- Organizing discussions/lectures on new developments, policy changes/ guidelines etc at the centre, State governments/MHRD, UGC, AICTE.
- Preparation of the Annual quality Assurance report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of NAAC to be submitted to NAAC.
